



Andrée Cooligan is the Senior Trade Commissioner and Commercial Counsellor at the Embassy of Canada in Berlin since September 2010. In a management position, Ms. Cooligan oversees multiple commercial projects between Canada and Germany, namely the promotion of Canadian exports to Germany, the development of science and technology partnerships between the two countries, and the strategic positioning of Canada as a location for investment by German firms.

In addition to promoting inbound investment to Canada, Ms. Cooligan works with Canadian companies in the Defence, and Ocean/marine technologies sectors, with a focus on selling to the German government. Ms. Cooligan's experience as Senior Trade Commissioner in Finland, Turkey and as Trade Commissioner in Thailand is supplemented by the expertise of more than 25 German and Canadian trade commissioners and assistants in Berlin, Düsseldorf and Munich, all supporting bilateral trade, bilateral investment and scientific cooperation.
