Prof. Toivonen received training in Internal Medicine and Cardiology in Helsinki University, Finland, and in Cardiac Electrophysiology in University of Michigan, MI, USA, during 1978-1988. Presently he is Chief Physician in Cardiac Electrophysiology and Pacemaker Division in Helsinki University Hospital, Finland.

Prof. Toivonen has conducted research in the fields of electrocardiography, cardiac electrophysiology, cardiovascular pharmacology and genetics of cardiac arrhythmia disorders. He has published 250 original papers in peer reviewed scientific journals and supervised 8 Doctoral Dissertations. He has taken part in the Steering Committee and Adjudication Committee for several multinational pharmacologic studies.

Prof. Toivonen has developed telemedicine service for ambulatory electrocardiography since 2005 in collaboration with RemoteA Ltd, Finland. Presently he belongs to telemedicine team of university hospital-affiliated cardiologists who provide ambulatory ECG interpretations and consultations for primary and secondary health care centres in Finland.
